Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year to all our families! The children have had a busy start to the school year, with Citizenship Clubs already started and a successful Scottish Afternoon.

Term 3 Curriculum

The ELCC and school will be looking at **Scottish history** this term for topic, exploring places, investigating artefacts and comparing today's society with the past. The pupils will have discussions about current scientific news items and revise how to use digital technologies safely. For Maths, the school and ELCC will be focussing on angles, directions, symmetry and charts and graphs. In Literacy, pupils have already been looking at Scots language by practising their Scots poem and looking at different texts in Scots. Pupils will be learning about fiction and non-fiction texts, making notes and using notes to create new texts.

Scottish Afternoon

Pupils thoroughly enjoyed their Scottish Afternoon this week. We gathered in the hall excitedly for an afternoon of performances, from Scottish Country Dancing, to the Shooglie Wooglie, to performers from each class reading their Scots poem. After, pupils had some shortbread, oatcakes and Scottish cheese to give them some energy, before working in groups to attempt Mrs Smith's Scottish Quiz. Great fun was had by pupils and staff!
