Seasons for Growth

After our highly successful pilot of Seasons For Growth last session, we will again be running Seasons for Growth lessons. This is a programme for pupils who have experienced changes in their lives because of a death, separation or divorce, or another significant loss. When someone we know dies, or when a family member moves out of our home, or another big change happens it can be a sad time for us. 'Seasons for Growth' is a programme where children learn how to cope when difficult things like this happen.

New Wet Weather Arrangements
