

We can't believe that's the end of January already and half way through Term 3. It's been a busy start to the term. It's been lovely to hear the poetry reciting and Ceilidh music filling the corridors.

Term 3 Curriculum

This term pupils will be looking at different types of **energy** and how **technology** affects our daily lives. All classes will have a focus on learning **Scots Language** by listening, reading and performing **Scots poems**, **songs** and **stories**. Pupils will take part in learning **Scottish Country Dancing** and performing in front of an audience. For Maths this term students will be focusing on **angles**, **symmetry and data analysis**, which involves carrying out surveys, collecting information and displaying data in a variety of ways.

Craigrownie Park

At the last **Creativity Inspiring Learning Showcase**, we were put in touch with, **Hugh O'Neill**, the **Network and Standards Manager** from Argyll and Bute, who has been allocated money to spend at **Craigrownie Park**.
