Q: Can I get a referral through this line?

A: No, this is an advice-only service. If you want to make a referral/ Request for your child please speak with your Named professional.

Q: Is the advice line only for families?

A: No, professionals working with children can also call for advice.

Q: Who can I speak to?

- Speech and Language Therapists
- Occupational Therapists
- Physiotherapists
- Dietitians

Q: Will my child get seen quicker if I call?

A: No, but we can offer strategies while you wait.

Q: Can I call more than once?

A: Yes you can call as often as you need.

Q: I can't make these times, is there another way to speak with a therapist?

A: Unfortunately these are the only times our advice line is available at the moment, please prioritise time for the call if it is important to you.
